



DIRECTIONS TO RANCHO LAS PALMAS

From Palm Springs Airport (PSP) – 11 miles

Exiting the Airport, turn left onto El Cielo (0.5 mile), turn left onto Ramon Road (5.5 miles), turn right onto Bob Hope Drive (5 miles), turn left into Rancho Las Palmas Resort & Spa

From Ontario Airport (ONT) – 80 miles

Exiting the Airport, turn left onto Archibald Avenue (0.2 mile), merge onto the I-10 Eastbound (75 miles), take I-10 East, exit Bob Hope Dr/Ramon Road, turn right onto Ramon Road (0.4 mile), turn left onto Bob Hope Drive (5 miles), turn left into Rancho Las Palmas Resort & Spa

From Orange County-John Wayne Airport (SNA) – 110 miles

Exiting the Airport, stay straight to go onto Michelson Drive (0.1 mile), turn left onto Mac Arthur Blvd (0.4 miles), merge onto I-405 North toward Long Beach (0.6 mile), merge onto CA-55 North via EXIT 9A toward Riverside (12 miles), merge onto CA-91 East toward Riverside (31 miles), merge onto CA 60 East toward Indio (23 miles), merge onto I-10 East (37 miles), take I-10 East Exit Bob Hope Dr/Ramon Road, turn right onto Ramon Road (0.4 mile), turn left onto Bob Hope Drive (5 miles), turn left into Rancho Las Palmas Resort & Spa

From Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) – 135 miles

Exiting the Airport, merge onto S. Sepulveda Blvd toward I-105 East (0.7 mile), merge onto I-105 East (17 miles), merge onto I-605 North (13 miles), merge onto I-10 East (100 miles), take I-10 East Exit Bob Hope Dr/Ramon Road, turn right onto Ramon Road (0.4 mile), turn left onto Bob Hope Drive (5 miles), turn left into Rancho Las Palmas Resort & Spa

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

With close proximity to regional and international airports, breathtaking natural wonders, and historic attractions, Rancho Las Palmas Resort & Spa is perfectly situated for travel-planning ease. The Palm Springs Airport, Ontario Airport, Orange County-John Wayne Airport, and Los Angeles International Airport service all incoming flights. Each airport provides a variety of ground transportation to Rancho Las Palmas, including on-site car rentals, limousine services and airport shuttles. HOTEL RESERVATIONS AND ROOM RATE

The room rate, which is subject to the current applicable occupancy and sales tax per room, per night, is \$299 Single/Double Occupancy and the resort fee has been waived for meeting attendees. The room rate and waived resort fee includes the following amenities:

- In-room High Speed Internet
- Access to the Fitness Center
- In-room Coffee and Tea Service
- Delivery of Daily Newspaper
- Complimentary Valet and Self Parking
- Nightly turndown service
- Two complimentary bottles of water daily

In order to make your hotel reservation you must first register for the meeting with the IADC. Once registered, the IADC will send you a link to the resort's secured reservation Web site along with your registration confirmation that will allow you to secure a hotel room at Rancho Las Palmas. Online reservations, along with a one night room and tax deposit, must be received by January 12, 2012. An individual's deposit is refundable to that individual if the resort receives notice of cancellation at least seven days prior to scheduled arrival. Individual guest room reservations canceled after this time will forfeit the one night deposit. Availability of rooms at the group rate is subject to the IADC room block and for reservations made by January 12, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. (CST) when unused rooms will be released. Reservation requests received after the room block has been fully reserved or after the release of unused rooms after 5:00 p.m. (CST) on January 12, 2012 will be accepted on a space available basis at the group rate. Please note the room block may fill before January 12, 2012, so we encourage you to register with the IADC so you can make your hotel reservation early.

Check-in time is 4:00 p.m. and check out time is 12:00 p.m.



WEATHER

The average temperatures in the Palm Springs area in February are mid-70s F/mid-20s C during the day and high-50s F/high-10s C at night. Weather can always be unpredictable though so we encourage you to check the forecast as the meeting gets closer at www.weather.com.

ATTIRE

Meetings and Events: Resort casual (slacks, shorts, golf shirt, button down/blouse) is appropriate for committee meetings and CLE programs. The Welcome Reception and other receptions call for comfortable and casual dress, although please note that it does get even cooler in the evenings so shorts may not be appropriate. For the Theme Party, comfortable and casual western attire (jeans, cowboy boots and hats) is requested and for the Gala, formal (black tie) attire is requested.

Golf course attire: Proper golf attire is required. No jeans or cut-off shorts. No metal spikes allowed.

IADC CANCELLATION POLICY

A CASH REFUND, less a \$150 processing fee, will be made if a written notice of cancellation is received by the IADC office more than thirty (30) days prior to the first day of the meeting. No reason for the cancellation need be provided for a timely notice of cancellation.

NO CASH REFUND will be made if notice of cancellation is received by the IADC office thirty (30) days or less prior to the first day of the meeting. However, if special circumstances arise before the meeting which prevent attendance, a member may request a future meeting credit. The request needs to be in writing and submitted to the IADC office. It should be directed to the Finance Committee's attention and note the special circumstances which caused cancellation. The credit request can only apply to meeting registration fees (not air, hotel, activity, tour, or special event fees) and, if approved, will be valid for use toward any IADC meeting for one (1) year from the date of the meeting for which credit is requested. A \$150 processing fee will be deducted from the total future meeting credit.

All future meeting credit requests will be considered by the Finance Committee and the decision of that Committee will be final.
