Law360 advice to GC regarding 'immigration uncertainty;' 1) stay the course, as nothing has changed yet and most change will be result of regulation and executive action; 2) get H-1B petitions submitted as soon as possible due to potential time impact as a result of US Citizenship and Immigration Services announcement of a six-month suspension of premium, or expedited, processing of H-1B visas beginning April 3<sup>rd</sup> and uncertainty of future regulations; 3) rethink treaty-based visas in light of Trump's threat to renegotiate NAFTA and consider changing hiring and onboarding practice to allow hiring under different type of visa; and 4) prepare for delays, audits, and site visits; employers will feel time and cost impact from additional scrutiny of petitions, including requests for evidence demonstrating particular educational degree, and expected increase in audits. Advise developing a protocol to handle ICE visits and increased worksite enforcement, including policies on I-9 completion, storage and retention, and periodic internal audits.
