HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICIES

The IADC will continue to monitor and update its members on the latest COVID travel requirements to Germany. In addition, we are monitoring the situation in Ukraine closely and, should it become unsafe to travel to Berlin and therefore impossible to proceed with our meeting, attendees will be notified immediately, and registration fees and hotel room deposits will be refunded accordingly.

Germany Drops Proof of COVID Vaccination or Negative COVID Test

As of June 14, all COVID-19 entry restrictions to Germany have been lifted. Entry to Germany is permitted for all travel purposes. It is no longer necessary to present proof of vaccination, proof of recovery, or a negative test result for entry to Germany.

U.S. Drops COVID Testing for Return flights

If you are registered or are planning to join us in Berlin for the Annual Meeting, please note that the United States just dropped the requirement for a pre-departure COVID test to enter the country.
