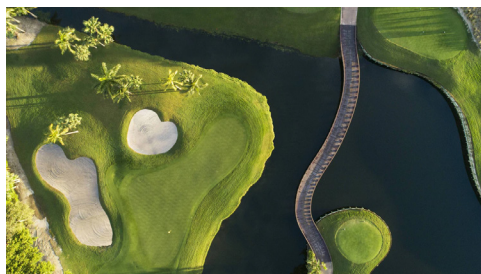

## Speed–Networking for IADC Members

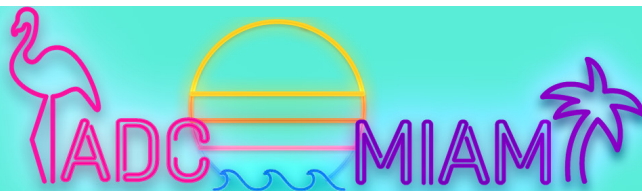
**Monday, February 19, 3:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.**

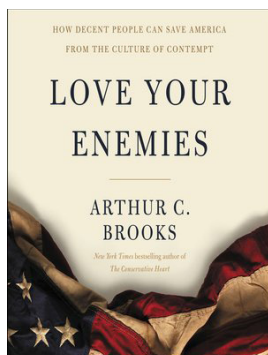
## Yoga

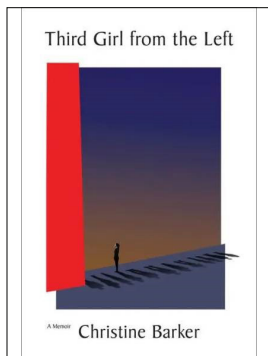
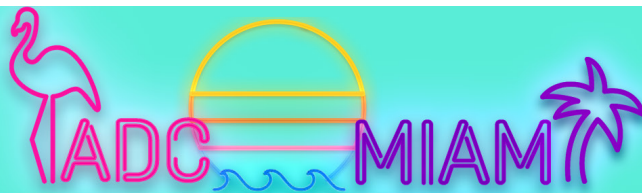
## Little Havana Culinary Tour

## The Empowerment Collaborative Activity: Meet the Author – Christine Barker

**Wednesday, February 21, 2:30 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.**

Christine Barker left her home in Santa Fe, New Mexico for New York City, which in the late '70s and '80s was a creative mecca for aspiring painters, writers, musicians, poets, and performers. In her memoir, *Third Girl from the Left*, she recalls her time in the heart of the city's creative scene when as an aspiring dancer, she is cast in national tours and off-Broadway performances before landing her lucky break – a job in the prestigious London production of *A Chorus Line*, playing a role she later repeats on the Broadway stage. She is soon joined in New York by her eldest brother, Laughlin, a divorced father and corporate lawyer, who comes out as a gay man and meets his business and life partner, Perry Ellis. Together they build the Perry Ellis fashion label. The siblings, their friends, and their partners are living the lives they hoped for, filled with possibility, freedom, and creative fulfillment when the AIDS crisis hits. Barker throws into sharp relief the suffering witnessed and endured by a generation of artists whose losses were compounded by the indignity and stigma of facing an epidemic that neither their traditional families nor the public at large was prepared to address. This spirited, illuminating insider account of performing on the major stage becomes a gutting portrait of grief, family dynamics, and marginalization of a vulnerable population. Barker's journey is like that of many young women who successfully navigate highly competitive careers only to be faced with unexpected circumstances that force her to make impossible choices. *Third Girl from the Left* earned a rave review from the *NYTimes*, was chosen as a *NYTimes* Editor's Choice, and was featured as a "Buzz Book" on Good Morning America.

*Third Girl from the Left* is a must-read that will educate and inspire. Plus, SPOILER-ALERT, Christine meets her husband, IADC member Bill Ruskin, on her journey! Christine has attended over 13 years of IADC meetings with Bill and is thrilled to discuss her book with us and answer questions during the event.
