Networking can be one of the most powerful and productive activities an individual can do to enhance both their professional and personal relationships.

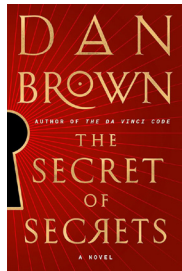

BOOK REVIEW: THE SECRET OF SECRETS BY DAN BROWN

Tuesday, July 7, 1:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.

The world's most celebrated thriller writer returns with his most stunning novel yet—a propulsive, twisty, thought-provoking masterpiece that will entertain readers as only Dan Brown can do.

OLD TOWN WALKING TOUR

Sunday, July 5, 12:30 p.m. - 2:30 p.m. and Tuesday, July 7, 1:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Follow your guide and let the city, where there is a secret to discover behind every single corner, enchant you. The city walk views Old Town Square providing a dazzling panorama. Stand in the middle and turn in a slow circle: it's as if all the most charming city streets of Europe were stretched around you. Every building is different in every detail - the elegant tower of the Old Town Hall, the proud silhouette of the fairytale Týn's Church, the monumental Church of St. Nicholas, and countless multicolored houses of many styles lend this place a unique atmosphere, which will captivate all those who decide to take a look at its charm. Take a closer look to the Astronomical Clock on Old Town Hall, as well as Estates Theatre and Wenceslas Square.

The registration fee is 600 CZK per person (approx. USD \$35/pp) and includes a professional tour guide and water.

PRAGUE CRAFT BEER TOUR

Visit two breweries (Cobolis Brewery and Dva Kohouti Brewery) for tours and tastings.

The registration fee is 3,610 CZK per person (approx. USD \$175/pp) and includes round-trip transportation, a brewmaster guide, beer tastings at two micro-breweries, and bar snacks.

PRAGUE CASTLE TOUR

Monday, July 6 and Wednesday, July 8, 1:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Prague Castle illustrates a thousand years of development of European architecture. It is devoted to gardens and fountains, towers and churches, palaces and summerhouses. Today the castle is the residence of the head of state. See the impressive St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, and stroll the Golden Lane with its picturesque and colorful houses, shops, and cafes.

The registration fee is 1,650 CZK per person (approx. USD \$80/pp) and includes a professional tour guide, one-way transportation to the Castle, headsets, water, and admission into St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, and the Golden Lane. Participants are free to stay and explore other areas of the Castle after the official tour concludes.

JEWISH QUARTER TOUR

The present shape of the Prague Jewish Quarter is the result of an extensive reconstruction carried out around 1900, in which only a few significant architectural relics of the thousand-year-long history of the Prague Jews have been preserved. The visit to the Jewish Quarter takes you into the Maisel Synagogue, Pinkas Synagogue, Old Jewish Cemetery, the Old-New Synagogue, and the Spanish Synagogue.

The registration fee is 1,500 CZK per person (approx. USD \$75/pp) and includes a professional tour guide, headsets, water, and admissions to the Maisel Synagogue, Pinkas Synagogue, Jewish Cemetery, Old-New Synagogue, and Spanish Synagogue. Please note: This is a walking tour.

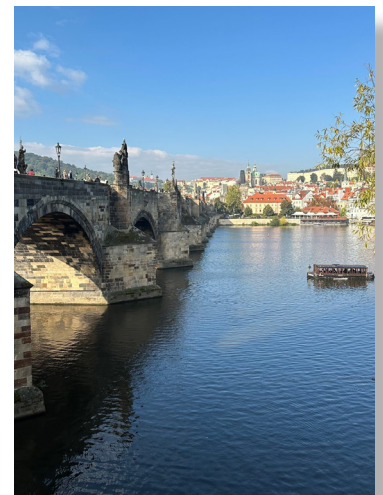

RÜCKL GLASS FACTORY IN NIZBOR

Wednesday, July 8, 1:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Rückl glassworks is located in Nizbor, Central Bohemia in the picturesque valley of the Berounka River.

Established in 1846, Rückl proudly takes traditional Czech glassmaking craft to a new level. Rückl combines the noble beauty of mouth-blown, hand-cut crystal with unique designs and intricate details. During the guided tour, visitors will witness all the individual steps and traditional techniques of the glass-manufacturing process. Participants will be able to try cutting their own design into a glass that they will be able to take home with them.

The registration fee is 2,330 CZK per person (approx. USD \$115/pp) and includes a professional guide, round-trip transportation, water, and admission to the factory and glass cutting workshop.

VISIT TO TEREZIN MEMORIAL

Thursday, July 9, 11:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Terezín was established at the end of the 18th century as a fortress, located at the confluence of the Labe (Elbe) and Ohře (Eger) rivers. Though innovative for its time, it eventually became obsolete and lost its military purpose.

Recently, Terezín has gained recognition as a symbol of Nazi persecution, where thousands of innocent people suffered and died during World War II.

The 1947 National Suffering Memorial honors victims of Nazi crimes. About an hour northwest of Prague, this former ghetto and concentration camp reveals a tragic history. In 1941, Jewish communities from the region were deported through Terezín en route to Auschwitz and Treblinka. Visiting the Gestapo prison and Terezín Museum, with artifacts, children's drawings, and survivor items, offers a powerful insight into this dark era.

The registration fee is 3,550 CZK per person (approx. USD \$170/pp) and includes a professional tour guide, headsets, round-trip transportation, boxed lunch, water, and admission to the Small Fortress, Ghetto Museum, and Magdeburg Barracks.
