

Stanford Conferences Networking

This sheet shows the current setup for Stanford Conferences network offering.

Note: For anyone with a SUNetID or part of an eduroam institution (can be checked [here](#)), select the “eduroam” network and use your SUNetID/NetID and password to log in for an easier and longer connection. Attendees that are Stanford affiliated must reach out to their local IT for network support as R&DE IT does not manage their devices.



How to get online (for Apple devices, ensure Private WiFi Address is turned off by following these steps:

To access sponsored wireless guest service:

1. Open wifi settings on your device, and select "**Stanford**" not "Stanford Visitor" when you are on the Stanford University campus.



2. If the *Network Registration* page does not open automatically, open a browser and load any URL to display a Stanford WebLogin page and select the blue Sponsored Wireless Guest button.

Welcome to Stanford

It looks like your computer is not registered for use on the Stanford network. Stanford faculty, staff, students and affiliates should register their device for ongoing access. For temporary guest access switch to the Stanford Visitor wireless network or use Sponsored Wireless Guest.

Stay connected. Use a consistent MAC address to avoid re-registering.

Stanford Network Registration has two steps

Step 1:

Choose the Network registration option and provide device and campus location information

Step 2:

Download and run the Stanford Device Registration tool (Mac and Windows users)

Stanford | Network Registration

To gain network Access, you must provide a **username** and **password** created for you by a Student, Faculty, or Staff member.

Note: **Android Users** please open this application in your devices main browser.

Sponsored Wireless Guest

If you have a sponsored wireless guest user ID or a Stanford Guest Account.

If you need an ID, talk to someone from Stanford. Most students, faculty and staff can sponsor a Stanford Guest Wireless ID for you by browsing to <http://wirelessguest.stanford.edu>

3. Log in with your sponsored guest username and password. After you log in, you can use Internet services and web browsing as you would at a public venue such as Starbucks.

Note: Please note, that you may be required to re-authenticate every 12 hours. Additionally, as a Stanford guest account sponsor, you are responsible for your guests' Internet use as well as any reported misuse.


Method 2 - Stanford Visitor - (For Conferences 2 Weeks or Longer)

With the Stanford Visitor network, you can use the university's wireless network to access the Internet while on campus. The Stanford Visitor network is intended for the average Stanford visitor — not visitors who need access to special applications.

The visitor network offers limited bandwidth, and **sessions are limited to 12 hours**. Services are limited to email, web browsing, VPN, and SSH, and visitors on this wireless network are not part of Stanford University IP space— meaning firewalls on campus may give you less access than if you use the Sponsored Guest wireless.

How to get online

1. Select the SSID **Stanford Visitor** from your device's list of available wireless networks.
2. If the *Network Registration* page does not open automatically, open a browser and load any URL; you will be redirected to an access page (on a mobile phone, the access page should open automatically).



3. Click **Accept** to acknowledge the terms of use. Your browser will be sent to a confirmation page, and from there you can get online.

Restrictions

The Stanford Visitor network has the following restrictions:

- Maximum download and upload speed: 8 Mbps
- No access to Stanford IP restricted resources (such as databases & journals)
- Limited network services

Note: To use another network, you may need to register with it.
