Downtown Dubai Area:

- 1. Downtown Dubai – Inti Dubai** – With Burj Khalifa views and an open-air terrace, this new terrace is a must-visit. Much attention to detail has been paid to the décor, and from the eye-catching lamps to intricate wall carvings, the space feels contemporary and authentically Latin American.

Downtown Dubai (Address Downtown) – Urla** – The setting of Urla is undeniably pretty, with a large tree taking centre stage inside a spherical marble bar, with the world’s tallest building standing proud in the background. There is plenty of tables dotted across the terrazzo floor, sectioned off with greenery and large umbrellas. Those

who want a full-fountain experience should book at night, but there is something to be said for a late lunch at this alfresco spot.

- 3. DIFC – Amazonico Dubai** – Take a trip to Copacabana without leaving the urban jungle at Latin American restaurant, Amazonico’s Fabulous rooftop. - 4. DIFC Waldorf Astoria - Bull & Bear** - Inspired by the original steakhouse of the same name in New York’s now-closed Waldorf Astoria hotel, Bull & Bear is a sophisticated place for fantastic food and spot-on service. Boasting a menu of playful takes on American favourite – its black onyx beef steaks are some of the bests in town – a grown-up crowd, carefully curated mixed drinks and regular live jazz nights are the makings for a perfect Dubai evening. - 5. Gate Village 4, DIFC- GAIA** - Named after the Greek Goddess of Earth, GAIA is a fashionable gaff in the business of reinterpreting Greek classics to impressive effect. A predominantly white colour palette, marble detailing and black-and-white photography provide a stylish backdrop to this contemporary taverna.

The menu comes courtesy of chef Izu Ani and talented chef de cuisine Orestis Kotefas, with tremendously fresh seafood the star of the show. Be sure to check out the ice market, where seasonal produce is hand-picked and cooked to order. One of Dubai’s best restaurants, and often one of its toughest to nab a table at.
