

My name is Margaret A. Heitz.
I live at 12 West Meridian Street,
New Britain, New State. My date
of birth is November 17, YR-44. I am
a college graduate.

On November 18, YR-2 I was
walking to work downtown when
I was struck by a bus. I had left
my house at 8 a.m. as usual and
had taken the subway to the Bowdoin
Street Station. I had a meeting
scheduled for 9:30 a.m. where I was
going to make a presentation to the
board of directors.

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I crossed halfway over Cambridge Street and stopped on the island by the crosswalk. I had to wait about a minute until the pedestrian light turned to "WALK" and then started across. I had the right of way. Suddenly a bus came from my left ^{MM} right and I got hit by the side of the bus. I was not more than two feet off the island in the crosswalk when I was hit.

The bus driver came up to me while I was lying on the ground and started yelling at me. I did not say

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anything to him. Other people at the scene were talking to him and telling him to calm down. When he finally did he said, "I'm sorry, I never saw you. I was looking up Bowdoin Street."

I have felt very bad since the accident and I have been unable to work. I am worried that I may lose my job because I am not working well and one of my managers has never liked me and may try to get rid of me if I don't get back to work soon.

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I have been having neck and shoulder pain since the accident.

I have never had any medical problems in my life.
