Wednesday November 15, 2023.

- 12:00 – 1:45 pm Lunch at Au Pied de Cochon, Hotel Presidente Intercontinental, Polanco. Walking distance from the Club de Industriales where the meeting is taking place.
- Dress code: Formal. Jacket required. Optional tie.
- 2:00 – 6:00 pm IADC Meeting at Club de Industriales located next door to the Marriott Hotel and a five-minute walk from the lunch venue.
- *For those guests not participating in the IADC meeting, there will be a visit to the Museo Soumaya in Polanco. This museum has Mexican art exhibits as well as modern art collections from worldwide renown artists.
- Duration of visit 2 to 3 hours.
- Cost: Free entrance to Museum + transportation fee (see final remarks at the end of the program).



- November 15, 2023.
- 6:30 pm Meet at Presidente Intercontinental Hotel Lobby to depart for dinner.
- Dinner will take place at one of the best Mexican Restaurants in Mexico City, San Angel Inn, located in the southern part of the city.
- Dress code: Business Casual



Thursday November 16, 2023

- 8:30 am – 12:30 pm Meet at Presidente Intercontinental Hotel lobby to depart for visit to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe where the original shrine with Her image is kept and remains available for the public to admire. This is the second most visited catholic shrine in the world.
- Duration: 2 – 3 hours.
- Cost: Voluntary donation + transportation fee (see final remarks at the end of Program).
- 1:30 pm Lunch at restaurant Azul Histórico located walking distance from Mexico City's main square and Plaza de la Constitución.




November 16, 2023 afternoon.

- 3:30 pm – 5:30 pm Guided walking tour through Mexico City's Main Square and surrounding historical buildings, including the Cathedral and the Templo Mayor Museum, Palacio de Bellas Artes and Postal Palace.
- Cost; USD 150 for the group + transportation fee (see final remarks at the end of Program).
- Dress code: Casual. Wear comfortable shoes. Hat and sunblock are recommended.



Friday November 17, 2023

- 9:30 pm Meet at Presidente Intercontinental Hotel lobby to depart for visit to the National Anthropology and History Museum.
- Duration of visit around 3 hours.
- 1:30 pm Suggested lunch at Centro Asturiano, one of the best Spanish restaurants in Mexico City and located in the Polanco area.
- After lunch a short distance walk to nearby Paseo de la Reforma is suggested where great Photography Exhibits are in place.
- Cost: Entrance to museum USD 5.00 per person + transportation fee (see final remarks at the end of the program).





- **Saturday November 18, 2023**
- 8:30 am. Meet at Presidente Intercontinental Hotel lobby to depart for visit to the pyramids at Teotihuacán.
- Duration of visit around 6 hours.
- Upon return to the Hotel, late lunch is suggested at a taco place in Polanco area. Snacks will be provided during the visit.
- Cost: Entrance to Pyramid Complex USD 5.00 USD + transportation fee (see final remarks at the end of the Program).
- Dress code: Casual. It is suggested to wear comfortable shoes, hat and sunblock.

Sunday November 19, 2023

- 8:30 am Meet at Presidente Intercontinental Hotel Lobby to depart for visit to the Palacio Nacional de Bellas Artes to watch the National Folkloric Ballet. This is a magnificent spectacle worth waking up early on a Sunday! It features dances and typical costumes and gowns from the different Mexican states. A picturesque performance not to be missed. Show starts at 9:30 am.
- Duration of show around 2 hours
- Cost of ticket for Ballet Performance USD 85.00 + transportation fee (see final remarks at the end of Program)
- Dress code: Casual

- Transportation fee is US 50.00 per person per day.
