Timothy St. John Ellam Q.C. is a Partner at McCarthy Tétrault (Calgary), and a member of the Firm's Litigation and IP groups. Previously, he was on the Firm's Board of Partners. Mr. Ellam frequently works with the McCarthy Tétrault London office on significant international arbitration matters as well as litigation proceedings in the High Court of Justice (Commercial Court). He is co-chair the firm's International Arbitration Practice Group.

Mr. Ellam regularly advise clients on intellectual property disputes and related commercial matters, as well as international arbitrations in the energy sector. He has appeared as senior counsel in patent, licensing, energy and technology related trials, arbitrations, and hearings. In 2014, he was appointed Queen's Counsel.
