Markus is the Firmwide Chair of Perkins Coie's White Collar & Investigations Practice. Prior to joining the law firm, Markus served as a decorated federal prosecutor in Chicago, Section Chief with the U.S. State Department-Balkans, clerk with the federal court of appeals and district court, and law professor teaching about bribery, corruption and comparative criminal law at institutions including Oxford University, the University of Chicago, and Northwestern University. Since 2010, he has been the Founding Co-Chair of the ABA's Global Anti-Corruption Committee. Markus, who successfully tried 25 federal and state civil and criminal jury cases and has directed more than 500 investigations, regularly advises public and private entities and individuals on challenging ethics and compliance matters, leads trans-national internal investigations, and negotiates resolutions with US and foreign enforcers.

In addition to authoring more than 100 law-related academic and popular articles, as well as chapters on a wide variety of topics, Markus has penned a number of books, including: *From 'Baksheesh' to Bribery: Understanding the Global Fight Against Corruption and Graft* (forthcoming 2018, Oxford University Press); *The ABA Compliance Officer Deskbook* (American Bar Association, 2017); and *Mutual Legal Assistance Treaties and Letters Rogatory: A Guide for Judges* (Federal Judicial Center, 2014). He also carries the distinction of having received both the Department of Justice's Attorney General's Award for the Nation's top trial performance and the State Department's Superior Honor Award for service to the country.
