- Diffuse Opponent's Arguments
- Anticipate what jurors want or need to know
- Clear up mysteries

- Cover all Hurdles to Recovery
- Use Verdict Form
- Make the Ask of Jury (Defense Verdict)
- Admitted Liability (Give a Number "Up to")
