



## **George J. Lavin, Jr. Memorial Scholarship**

**2020 IADC Trial Academy  
July 25-31, 2020, Stanford Law School**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The law firm of Lavin, Cedrone, Graver, Boyd & DiSipio has agreed to fund a full tuition scholarship honoring the firm's founder, George J. Lavin, Jr. Mr. Lavin served as Director of the 2001 Trial Academy and as a faculty member of the 1999 Trial Academy. Mr. Lavin was an accomplished trial lawyer and the scholarship celebrates the commitment he had to mentoring aspiring trial lawyers.

### **SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship includes the registration fee (\$2,995) and the housing and meal package (\$1,995) to attend the 2020 Trial Academy in July. It also includes a \$250 stipend to be used toward incidental expenses. The winner is responsible for travel and incidentals.

### **CANDIDATES**

Mr. Lavin spent much of his career representing non-profit organizations. To honor this legacy, the Firm would like the George J. Lavin Memorial Scholarship to be awarded to a candidate who is employed by a non-profit corporation, non-profit organization, or a public sector entity. Successful candidates will demonstrate a dedication to this kind of practice and an interest in expanding their knowledge of trial law.

### **METHOD OF SELECTION**

Applications are due by April 6, 2020. They will be reviewed by the selection committee and the successful applicant will be notified by May 1, 2020.
