

Honorable Gary L. Miller

Hon. Gary L. Miller was first elected to the Marion County bench in 1990 and served in Criminal Court 5 for 10 years. He served as Judge in the Marion Superior Court, Civil Division, Room 5 in Indianapolis from January of 1991 until December of 2008. He was reappointed to the bench by Indiana Governor Mitch Daniels in 2013 and is currently presiding in Civil Division, Room 3. He received his A.B. degree from Indiana University in Bloomington in 1977, and his J.D. in 1980 from the Indiana University School of Law at Indianapolis.

Judge Miller has served as an adjunct Professor of Law at the Indiana University School of Law in Indianapolis since 1992. He teaches Trial Practice and Professional Responsibility. In 2003 he served as president of the Indianapolis Bar Association.

Judge Miller has lectured on criminal and civil law, trial tactics, and legal ethics issues. He has made presentations to many national groups, including the Indiana Judicial Center, American Probation and Parole Association, Commercial Law League of America, Indiana State Bar Association, Indiana Trial Lawyers Association, American Bar Association, Transportation Lawyers of America, Defense Research Institute, Ohio Association of Civil Trial Attorneys, International Society of Primerus Law Firms, the Evansville Bar Association, NITA, and the St. Louis Bar Association.
