SUGGESTED "BEISL" RESTAURANTS AND "WIRTSHAEUSER"

"Beisl" is the Viennese name for a casual and cozy restaurant with relaxed atmosphere. A Beisl serves local cuisine, hearty mother's kitchen of excellent, home made quality and very often huge portions. The service is friendly and fast. The Beisl is a typical Viennese institution, the pendant to the French Bistro, the English Pub, the Italian Trattoria, the New York Diner and the Bavarian Beer Cellar.

"Wirtshaus" is the upgraded version for a Beisl.

Dress code: strictly casual.

BIERAMT

Viennese and international cuisine. Various kinds of draft beer. They offer a great variety of Schnapps. **Open:** Daily from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

DA MAX - GRILLHOUSE

The new interpretation of a Beisl located in the 1st district: modern design meets delicious dishes from the Josper grill, Casolettes, home-made burgers and juicy steaks! A large variety of beers is available, both local draft beers and international bottled specialties.

Open: daily from noon to midnight

ECKEL

A charming small restaurant in the 19th district of Vienna. 3 different sections, one part is very informal, rustic setting, resembles a "Beisl" in its best. The other two parts are in a typical Austrian elegant country style. It is very popular with Viennese and definitively the answer when someone asks you about the "quiet tip". Austrian and intl. cuisine, great wine selection.

Open: Tuesday to Saturday from 11:30 a.m. to 02:30 p.m. and 06:00 p.m. to 10:30 pm, closed on Sunday & Monday.

GASTWIRTSCHAFT HUTH

Contemporary Beisl restaurant with stylish interior. Offers traditional and new Viennese cuisine as well as specialties from all Austrian provinces. During summer time, restaurant offers seats in a small garden as well. **Open:** Daily from 11:30 a.m. to midnight.

GLACIS BEISL

The Glacis Beisl is located in a 300 year-old building that once served military purposes. Under the motto "Viennese with a twist" it offers a modern interpretation of traditional Viennese and Austrian cuisine. The interior of the Glacis Beisl is made of dark wood, thus creating a cozy atmosphere inviting you to stay. **Open**: daily from 11:00 am – 02:00 am

GRIECHENBEISL

One of Vienna's oldest restaurants with many small vaulted rooms, upstairs and downstairs, truly a piece of ancient Vienna. The first entry still preserved in the registers of the Municipality of Vienna dates from 1447, and it states that the house was sold for 550 pounds of pfennings. A tower with a steep saddled roof is the last remnant of the old city wall (about 1200), and it is, therefore, the most ancient building in Vienna. Local and international cuisine, many small rooms in different settings. Fresh trout and very good beef roasts. Pilsner beer, local wines. **Open:** Daily from 11:00 a.m. to 01:00 a.m.

MAGAZIN DREI HACKEN

The combination of the restaurant serving typical Viennese dishes with the in-house vinotheque "VINUM" turns the 3 Hacken Magazin to a meeting place for lovers of traditional food and exquisite wines. The spacious showroom can also be used for wine tastings.

Open: Monday to Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to midnight (meals until 11:00 p.m.). Closed on Sundays.

MARTINJAK

This restaurant skilfully combines tratition with contemporary taste, not only in the architecture of the room but alson in the culinary concept. The menu includes classical Viennese dishes in a modern interpretation as well as seasonal, regional specialities on a high level.

Open: Tuesday to Saturday from 11:00 am to midnight.

OFENLOCH

One of the smallest but most charming restaurants in Vienna. It is a place where the Viennese enjoy their time off frequently. This restaurant intercedes the famous "Gemuetlichkeit", an Austrian quality which expresses their joy in live and which you will feel as soon as you enter our country. Austrian and International cuisine.

Open: Monday to Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to midnight (meals until 22.45 p.m.). Closed on Sundays.

PFARRWIRT

This lovely restaurant is located in a suburb in the north of Vienna. First built in 1180 as Berghof, the Pfarrwirt is considered to be one of the most precious art historical buildings in Vienna. Next to St. Jacobs Church with its Roman basements, the medieval house is situated on a hill and offers an enchanting view over the nearby Danube. Adhering to original recipes while accepting new trends are the two secrets of the Viennese cuisine, to which the Pfarrwirt feels committed.

Open: Tuesday to Sunday from noon to midnight. Closed on Mondays.

PLACHUTTAS GASTHAUS ZUR OPER

Conveniently located within walking distance to the Vienna State Opera, this charming restaurant reflects an exciting symbiosis between Viennese tradition and modern design. The culinary focus is on Wiener Schnitzel, prepared according to the original recipe, and other Viennese specialties.

Open: daily from 11.00 am to 00.30 am

PUERSTNER

They are famous for their "Pfandl". Stews and potato roast served in the hot, wrought-iron pan. Rustic and cozy setting. Centrally located near the Kaerntner Street, main shopping and pedestrian zone. **Open:** Daily from 10:00 a.m. to midnight.

RATHAUSKELLER

This restaurant is located in the basement of the Vienna City Hall (German: Rathaus), which was built at the end of the 19th century in neo-gothic style. The Rathauskeller offers the perfect atmosphere to enjoy the traditional Austrian flair and cuisine.

Open: Monday to Saturday from 11:30 a.m. to 03:00 p.m. and from 06:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Closed on Sunday and public holidays.

SCHNATTL

This place is especially known for its Schanigarten. Excellent variety of wines, Austrian cuisine. Near the city center. **Open:** Monday to Friday from 06:00 p.m. to midnight (meals until 11:00 p.m.), closed on weekends and public holidays.

STADTPARKBRÄU

Conveniently located next to the City Park, this country-style restaurant offers Austrian & international cuisine. Good selection of Austrian wines.

Open: Daily from 11:00 a.m. to 03:00 p.m. and from 06:00 p.m. to midnight.

STADWIRT

Restaurant consists of 3 parts: bar with some small tables invite for a cup of coffee, a glass of wine, some small traditional dishes or extraordinary snacks during the day; restaurant that offers traditional Austrian hospitality and modern interpretations of traditional dishes; living room for private atmosphere with garden during summer time. **Open:** Monday to Friday 09:00 a.m. to midnight, Saturday from 04:00 p.m. to 01:00 a.m., Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 04:00 p.m.

ZU DEN 3 HACKEN

The about 270 year old Beisl has a furniture made of dark wood. Famous names like Schubert or Nestroy who used to be guests at the "3 Hacken" 100 years ago are written on a sign at the entrance. This sign and the handwritten menu cards let you feel the effort in creating a personal atmosphere. They offer nouvelle cuisine (a variety of dishes without meat) as well as typical Viennese dishes.

Open: Monday to Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., closed on Sunday.

ZUM KUCKUCK

Typical Viennese "Beisl", very popular with the Viennese. Cozy and familiar & elegant atmosphere; this restaurant intercedes the famous "Gemuetlichkeit", an Austrian quality which expresses their joy in live and which you will feel as soon as you enter this restaurant. Austrian and International cuisine. Excellent service. Worthy of note is that this restaurant has put much emphasis on the offer of Viennese wines.

Open: Monday to Saturday from noon to 02:30 p.m. and from 06:00 p.m. to midnight, closed on Sunday.

ZUM LEUPOLD

This restaurant is situated on the edge of the inner district just near the Ringstrasse. It is a typical Viennese Beisl, rustic & fun and offers traditional Viennese cooking.

ALBERTINA PASSAGE

No doubt this is quite an unique restaurant: the exceptional location in a former pedestrian passage below the famous Ring Boulevard right next to the State Opera, the stylish interior design with geometrical patterns on the wall, the huge white bar and the white piano right in the middle of this first Viennese Dinner Club guarantee an extraordinary dinner experience.

Open: Tuesday to Saturday from 05:00 pm to 04:00 a.m.

AUBERGINE

This charming and small wine bar in the centre of town has a simple appearance but very comfortable ambiance. The restaurant leads into a culinary wonderland that includes traditional Austrian dishes as well as seasonal international specialties. The wine list is mammoth – about 800 bottled Austrian wines are available.

Open: Monday to Friday from 11:30 noon to 02:30 p.m. and 06:00 p.m. to midnight, Saturday from 06:00 p.m. to midnight, closed on Sundays & public holidays.

DA MORITZ

This contemporary restaurant with stylish interior offers light Mediterranean cuisine with a vast variety of pasta dishes and fresh fish. During summer time, the restaurant offers seats an a terrace as well. **Open:** daily from 11:30 a.m. to midnight.

DO & CO ALBERTINA

PROCACCI

The typical neo-classical 1800's building is located in the heart of the city and is the work of the famous architect Joseph Kornhaeusl. The mansion still today belongs to the Benedictine Monastery of Göttweig. Tradition and modernity are the principal elements that characterize this place and the specialties originating in its kitchen; rich in typical Tuscan dishes, revisited by expert chefs. The recipes, prepared with specially selected seasonal ingredients, are offered in combination with a wide array of wines, many of which come from the Antinori family's estates. **Open**: daily from 11:30 am to midnight.

VESTIBÜL
